Norwegian Jersey and Holstein included in Nordic Cattle Genetic Evaluation

The genetic evaluation done by Nordic Cattle Genetic Evaluation for dairy breeds in Denmark, Sweden and Finland will in the future also include Norwegian Jersey and Norwegian Holstein.

Tine, Norwegian Jersey, Norwegian Holstein and Nordic Cattle Genetic Evaluation (NAV) have agreed that Holstein and Jersey cows in Norway in the future should be genetic evaluated together with Holstein and Jersey cows in Sweden, Finland and Denmark.

Norwegian Holstein and Jersey data will be delivered by Tine to NAV, who conduct the genetic evaluation, and send breeding values back to TINE. TINE will publish the breeding values on the Norwegian cattle database so Norwegian Holstein and Jersey farmers get access to breeding values on their cows for NTM (Nordic Total Merit) and all traits included in NTM.

Norwegian Jersey and Holstein farmers will in the future have the possibility to be active players in the breeding program for Holstein and Jersey breeds along with breeders in Sweden, Finland and Denmark.
